



Club Subsidies Criteria – 2017

The Carlile Swimming Club offers a swimmer subsidy to assist swimmers who travel to National Championships and for other Club Sponsored Events. The provision of assistance is subject to the following criteria and is reviewed on an annual basis.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Member of Carlile Swimming Club Inc. for at least 90 days (in accordance with Swimming Australia Ltd 90 day rule).
2. For National subsidy applications, need to have competed for the club at the most recent NSW Championships (exemption if attending a Swimming Australia event or camp).
3. Make themselves available for club relays if selected.
4. When team accommodation is organized must stay with the team.
5. Family member/swimmer to assist with Technical Official duties as requested at Carlile Speedo Cup, Carlile JX Meet, Carlile Club Championships and/or obtain SNSW Accreditation as Check Starter, Marshal, Recorder, Starter etc. (at least two duties or accreditations in previous 12 months).
6. Full official club uniform is worn at ALL meets.

Subsidies can be revoked due to misconduct or failing to adhere to Club Code of Conduct

Subsidies are paid upon return from an event/trip net of any incidental costs incurred by the swimmer.

In addition to the Club's competitive & other events direct support of more than \$28000 annually, the swimmer subsidies and (maximum \$ per swimmer) currently approved are:

2. 2017 National Open Water Championships (Adelaide)	\$5000	\$200 / swimmer

4. 2017 Australian Open Championships (Brisbane)	\$2400	\$300 / swimmer
5. 2017 Bronze/Silver Activity	\$5000	\$100 / swimmer
6. 2017 National Short Course Championships (Adelaide)	\$5000	\$250 / swimmer

*\$250 plus \$25 per individual event swum up to a maximum of \$400 per swimmer

To receive a subsidy, eligible swimmers should apply for approval using the Subsidy Application Form and Code of Conduct & Medical Release Form, prior to the event.
